**Subject:** Important Announcement: All State of Vermont Email Addresses will be changing July 27, 2015

All State of Vermont email addresses will be changing this coming Monday, July 27, 2015 from [firstname.lastname@state.vt.us](#) to [firstname.lastname@vermont.gov](#). The reason for the change is to enhance security on state-owned email addresses, and all associated communications from the State. You will continue to receive email addressed to your old [firstname.lastname@state.vt.us](#) address until August 2016. **There is no action you need to take to start receiving and sending mail using the @vermont.gov address.**

- The State will be changing its email addresses from @state.vt.us to @vermont.gov and @partner.state.vt.us to @partner.vermont.gov on July 27, 2015.
- Starting on July 27, 2015 the email address that will appear as the “From” address when you send emails will be [firstname.lastname@vermont.gov](#). State partner emails will be [firstname.lastname@partner.vermont.gov](#)
  - Email addresses for the Legislature (from @leg.state.vt.us) and the Secretary of State (from sec.state.vt.us) will **not** be changing at this time.
- The “@us” ([@state.vt.us](#)) domain will no longer be dedicated to federal and state government entities, whereas the @gov ([@vermont.gov](#)) domain will continue to be reserved strictly for such entities.
- To help promote awareness of the change you should update your email signature, letterhead, business cards, agency/department websites, and any other public documentation that includes any state email address. These changes should be made after the effective date.
