As part of our migration to Office 365, we are negotiating two licensing bands in our Microsoft Enterprise Agreement. They are called E1 and E3 Government (formerly known as G1 and G3). The table below highlights the differences between the two bands. Below is a table of items in scope for our O365 migration project.

Action Needed: We need to work with a representative from each department or agency to identify E1 vs. E3 (formerly known as G1 and G3) users. Angela Leclerc is starting to work on FY16 Service Level Agreements (SLAs), and will provide a list of users (both employees and vendors) to departments and agencies as part of that process within the next few weeks in an effort to help identify users licensing needs. NOTE: *Vendor/partner accounts (both Email and SharePoint) will be eligible for E1 (Government) licensing only. The cost for those accounts are not included in the allocation, and departments/agencies will be assessed a fee of \$110 per account per year (as forecasted during FY2015 SLA discussions). This will be billed as part of the Service Level Agreement Demand Services billing annually.*
