
To Change display name in your Outlook Client (from <u>username@state.vt.us</u> to <u>username@vermont.gov</u>)

Edit Existing Profile:


CLOSE Outlook Client

- 1. Click on the **Start Button**.
- 2. Click **Control Panel**, found on the right-hand pane of the *Start Menu*.
- 3. The Control Panel window should open immediately.



Tip: By default, the Windows 7 Control Panel opens with the *Category* view. Change the view to *Large icons* or *Small icons*. This makes finding the applet you're after much easier.


4. Click on MAIL (32 bit)




5. Click DATA FILES



6. Select your mailbox Click SETTINGS



In the MAILBOX field remove whatever is there and type your new email address, in my case David.Fortin@vermont.gov
Then click on Okay.



That should update your display name.

Close out the control panel and re-open your Outlook Client.
